The Rohingya people, a Muslim ethnic minority from Myanmar, have endured decades of systemic persecution and violence. Numerous Rohingya were forced to flee their homeland to Bangladesh, where they now reside in overcrowded refugee camps, lacking hope, stability, and facing shortages of basic necessities. Those who have fled to other countries (Malaysia, India, Pakistan, and more) encounter uncertain legal statuses, harsh living conditions, and discrimination. Those who remain in Myanmar are caught in the middle of a violent civil war. The few who are able to be resettled to countries that grant citizenship quickly realize the difficult realities of being immigrants.

The Rohingya are a people who have not known peace for generations. They hope for peace, searching for it in religion or resettlement. Pray with us, that our Rohingya friends would encounter the true God of peace.
